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## **Release and Waiver of Liability**

This Release and Waiver of Liability ("Release") executed on the event date specified on associated registration form, by the signer ("Participant") in favor of Chinese American Semiconductor Professional Association ("CASPA"), a nonprofit corporation, and its advisors, directors, officers, employees, and agents.

The Participant desires to serve and/or work and/or participate as a participant in various capacities and/or positions, such as, but not limited to, member of Board of Advisor, member of Board of Director, member of Board of Volunteer, Officers, and/or event participants, for CASPA, and engages in activities related to being a participant for CASPA related events and/or activities ("Activities"). The Participant understands that the Activities may include certain tasks, such as traveling on behalf of CASPA, transporting goods on behalf of CASPA, performing physical labor, organizing and participating activities, providing event security/safety, exposing to undesirable/hazardous environment that may result in personal injuries.

The Participant hereby freely, voluntarily, and without duress executes this Release under the following terms:

### **1. Release and Waiver.**

Participant does hereby release and forever discharge and hold harmless CASPA and its successors and assigns from any and all liability, claims, and demands of whatever kind or nature, either in law or in equity that arise or may hereafter arise from Participant's Activities associated with CASPA.

PARTICIPANT UNDERSTANDS THAT THIS RELEASE DISCHARGES CASPA FROM ANY LIABILITY OR CLAIM THAT THE PARTICIPANT MAY HAVE AGAINST CASPA WITH RESPECT TO ANY BODILY INJURY, PERSONAL INJURY, ILLNESS, DEATH, OR PROPERTY DAMAGE THAT MAY RESULT FROM PARTICIPANT'S ACTIVITIES WITH CASPA, WHETHER CAUSED BY THE NEGLIGENCE OF CASPA OR ITS OFFICERS, DIRECTORS, EMPLOYEES, AGENTS OR OTHERWISE. PARTICIPANT ALSO UNDERSTANDS THAT CASPA DOES NOT ASSUME ANY RESPONSIBILITY FOR OR OBLIGATION TO PROVIDE FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE OR OTHER ASSISTANCE, INCLUDING BUT NOT LIMITED TO MEDICAL, HEALTH, OR DISABILITY INSURANCE IN THE EVENT OF INJURY OR ILLNESS.



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## **2. Medical Treatment.**

Participant does hereby release and forever discharge CASPA from any claim whatsoever which arises or may hereafter arise on account of any first aid, treatment, or service rendered in connection with the Participant's Activities in connection with CASPA.

## **3. Assumption of the Risk.**

The Participant understands that the Activities may involve work that may be hazardous to the Participant. Participant hereby expressly and specifically assumes the risk of injury or harm in the Activities, and releases CASPA from all liability for injury, illness, death, or property damage resulting from the Activities.

## **4. Insurance.**

The Participant understands that, except as otherwise agreed to by CASPA in writing, CASPA does not carry or maintain health, medical, or disability insurance coverage for any Participant. **Each Participant is expected and encouraged to obtain his or her own medical or health insurance coverage.**

## **5. Photographic Release.**

Participant does hereby grant and convey unto CASPA all right, title, and interest in any and all photographic images and video or audio recordings made by CASPA during the Participant's Activities with CASPA, including, but not limited to, any royalties, proceeds, or other benefits derived from such photographs or recordings.

## **6. Other.**

Participant expressly agrees that this Release is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of California, and that this Release shall be governed by and interpreted in accordance with the laws of the State of California. Participant also agrees that in the event that any clause or provision of this Release shall be held to be invalid by any court of competent jurisdiction, the invalidity of such clause or provision shall not otherwise affect the remaining provisions of this Release which shall continue to be enforceable.
